*Note: All students admitted to the clinical program have a full tuition remission for 5 academic years as well as the internship year (typically completed during the 6th year), and a 12-month stipend paid for 5 years in residency at Yale. For 2025-2026 the stipend is \$50,777. All students are required to serve as Teaching Fellows for four semesters (typically during the second and third years of graduate study). Students are paid a "top-up" by Yale if their internship salary is less than their graduate student stipend, provided that the internship year is completed no later than the 6th year. Students are also provided with comprehensive health insurance. Based on Fiscal Year 2026 budget numbers, the sum of tuition remission (\$50,900), stipend (\$50,777), health care for a single individual (\$3,422), health assessment (\$2,157), and ITS fees (\$534), sum to a total value of \$107,790 per year.
